The Mayor of Cairns Councillor Bob Manning signed a renewal of the Sister City agreement with the Lord Mayor of Lae James Khay at a dinner arranged by the Lae Urban Local Level Government at the Lae International Hotel on Friday night, attended by the Morobe Governor Kelly Naru and the Cairns Trade delegation, which incorporated two State MP's Michael Trout and Curtis Pitt.

Lae City has a lot to gain from such an agreement and in the past has done so by staff exchanges, cultural visits and technical assistance from the Cairns Council Engineers. The Mayor of Cairns was quick to point out the obvious magnificent tourist attractions of this country, and how Cairns that has benefited from Tourism is well situated to help PNG and in Morobe's struggling tourism industry.

The delegation visited the China Harbour Engineering Company for a presentation on the Tidal Basin project. The delegation members were able fit in 'one on one' visits with Lae Chamber members and visit some of the Lae businesses.

This is the first of what we hope to be a series of visits that will benefit the members of both Chambers. The Cairns Chamber members were quick to support our efforts to connect Cairns by a direct aircraft service.

ADB sounds note of caution on Lae port

The long-awaited project to expand Lae's port is 'ahead of schedule', according to the Asian Development Bank's Vice President (Operations 2) Stephen Groff, who visited Papua New Guinea last week to inspect progress.

The Lae port contractor, China Harbour Engineering, is expected to complete the project—70% of which is financed by ADB loans—by the end of 2014.

Groff sounded a note of caution during his visit, however.

'It's not just completing the port,' he told *The National* newspaper. 'The Government needs to think ahead about what they're going to use the port for. This is a critical piece of infrastructure for the Highlands Highway, so you need to think ahead about how you're going to use this port for imports and exports, and moving goods in and out of the area. What we don't want to see at the end of 2014 is physical infrastructure turned over [to the Government) and there's a couple of years before the port is really active. We would hope that the port would be fully functional and active sometime in 2015.'



APNG Services to Brisbane

Airlines PNG have today confirmed that the Codeshare Agreement with Virgin Australia on the Port Moresby to Brisbane route will not be renewed when the current agreement expires on 13 April 2013.

Muralee Siva, CEO of Airlines PNG, said "As part of our ongoing business review we have elected not to renew this agreement but instead will be directing all our focus onto the consolidation and further development of our domestic operations".

"In the first half of this year we will be bringing two new aircraft into domestic service and are directing a great deal of time and effort into revising our schedules and bringing our on-time performance up to the international benchmark of 85%. Over the first quarter of 2013 we have taken our figure over 78% - a significant achievement given the challenging operating conditions in PNG."

"We believe these initiatives will have great benefits for the people of PNG and that our time is better spent in them" Mr Siva added.

Passengers who hold bookings with Airlines PNG for travel after 13 April will have their bookings transfer across to Virgin Australia for the same date of travel. There will be no disruption to their travel plans.

Virgin Australia will continue to operate the route linking Australia and PNG with Airlines PNG maintaining sales links in order to maintain continuity of service for customers.
